

Foshan Bureau Welcomes Foreigners to Work

Foshan Foreign Trade and Economic Cooperation Bureau (Foshan Bureau) is a department of the municipal government of Foshan in the Pearl River Delta region. The bureau is responsible for the co-ordination and administration of affairs involving foreign trade, economic co-operation, foreign investment as well as port management.

The city of Foshan is a drive of only 45 minutes away from downtown Guangzhou, the provincial capital of Guangdong, with other Pearl River Delta cities as well as Hong Kong and Macao SARs within two hours of drive.

Foshan is one of the best-developed manufacturing and one of the wealthiest cities in the Delta region with dozens of industries having taken shape and a handful of advanced manufacturing industries and growth industries being taking off.

Foshan is attaching equal importance to the development of Sino-German Industrial Services Zone, which aims to foster industrial services such as R&D and design, test and certification, information sharing, conventions and exhibitions and vocational training and to become a model zone with management standards and a business environment similar to industrial parks in Germany.

Foshan is also known for being the ancestral home of martial arts movie icon Bruce Lee and its influence of martial arts with other big names including Yip Man and Wong Fei-hung being likewise popular among the Chinese home and abroad.

The city is also famous for its chefs and their mouthwatering delicacies among all.
